Game Wise Rules & Regulations:

❖ **Chess & Archery [Boys & Girls]:**

1. All general and standard rules will be applicable
2. Failure to report on time would lead to disqualification
3. Matches will be conducted under the guidance of the officials of the authorized chess academy / association only
4. Point system and other details will be briefed before the commencement of the event

❖ **Freestyle Swimming (Individual & Relay) & Race (Individual & Relay) [Boys & Girls]:**

1. All general and standard rules will be applicable
2. Participants for the medal round / final will be decided based on the winner of hits / time trial and shall be informed before the event
3. Failure to report on time would lead to disqualification from the hit / time trial
4. Games will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only

❖ **Long Jump & Discuss Throw [Boys & Girls]:**

1. All general and standard rules will be applicable
2. Winner will be decided based on attempts of participants on best of 3 hits. The best score / distance of a participant out of his / her 3 attempts will be considered for counting
3. Failure to report on time would lead to disqualification from the hit / final
4. Games will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only

❖ **5 a side Football [Boys & Girls]: Team: 5 + 2 (substitute players)**

1. Field Measurement: 20 mtr. X 12 mtr. (approx.)
2. Goal post: 6ft (length) X 4ft (height) [approx.]
3. Matches will be officiated by the officials of the authorized association only
4. Throw-in and corner rules as per standard 5 a side football norm and will be briefed by the officials
5. There will be no goal keeper and nobody can touch the ball with his / her hands. In case of penalty shoot, there will also be no goal keeper and a team needs to take the kick from the center only
6. Duration: 10 minutes (1st half) + 2 minutes(break) + 10 minutes (2nd half) [approx.]
7. In the group league matches (if any), if a team wins the match, the team will get 3 points and for draw games the playing teams will get 1 point each
8. On the knock out stage, in case of a draw game, a team will advance the next round or win the match based on penalty shootout (5 shootout each team, and after that sudden death)
9. If a team fails to report on time, the other team will be declared as the winner of the match and will be awarded full match points
10. If all the teams or 2 teams of a particular group have same points after all the group matches, the group winner will be decided as per following rules...
 - a) Goal difference
 - b) Number of goals scored
 - c) Head-to-head
 - d) Penalty shootout (in case of two teams of a group are on same point, same number of goals scored, have same goal difference and matches between them ended in draw)
 - e) Toss (if required)

❖ **Kabaddi [Boys & Girls]: Team: 7 + 5** (substitute players)

1. All general and standard rules will be applicable
2. Failure to report on time would lead to disqualification
3. Games will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only
4. Point system and other details will be briefed before the commencement of the event
5. Weight range with cloth for boys (no grace): **45 – 70 kgs**
6. Weight range with cloth for girls (no grace): **40 – 65 kgs**

❖ **Table Tennis (Singles & Doubles) [Boys & Girls]:**

1. Winner of a particular match will be decided based on best of 3 sets (each set of 11 points), applicable for all the matches of group league and knock out stage
2. Service, points, deuce and other rules as per standard TT rules and matches will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only
3. If a player / team fails to report on time, the other player / team will be declared as winner of the match
4. On winning a match a player / team will get 3 points (group league and other rounds)
5. If all the players / teams or 2 players / teams of a particular group have same points after all the group matches, the group winner will be decided as per following rules...
 - a) Number of sets won
 - b) Total number of points won
 - c) Head-to-head
 - d) Toss (if required)

❖ **Badminton (Singles & Doubles) [Boys & Girls]:**

1. Winner of a particular match will be decided based on best of 1 or 3 sets (each set of 21 points), applicable for all the matches of group league and knock out stage
2. Service, points, deuce, and other rules as per standard Badminton rules and matches will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only
3. If a player / team fails to report on time, the other player / team will be declared as winner of the match
4. On winning a match a player / team will get 3 points (group league and other rounds)
5. If all the players / teams or 2 players / teams of a particular group have same points after all the group matches, the group winner will be decided as per following rules...
 - a) Number of sets won
 - b) Total number of points won
 - c) Head-to-head
 - d) Toss (if required)

❖ **Basketball [Boys & Girls]: Team: 5 + 2** (substitute players)

1. Playing quarter: 5 minutes each quarter and total of 4 quarters. 1 minutes of break in between each quarter
2. Scoring Points, foul, time out and other rules as per standard basketball rules and matches will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only
3. In the group league matches, if a team win the match, the team will get 3 points and for draw games the playing teams will get 1 point each

4. On the knock out stage, in case of a draw game, a team will advance the next round or win the match based on playing of one extra quarter of 5 minutes
5. If a team fails to report on time, the other team will be declared as the winner of the match and will be awarded full match points
6. If all the teams or 2 teams of a particular group have same points after all the group matches, the group winner will be decided as per following rules...
 - a) Number of points scored in total
 - b) Scoring points difference
 - c) Head-to-head
 - d) Extra Quarter (in case of two teams of a group are on same point, same scoring point, same scoring points difference and matches between them ended in draw)
 - e) Toss (if required)

❖ **Volleyball [Boys & Girls]: Team:** 6 + 3 (substitute players)

1. Winner of a particular match will be decided based on best of 5 sets (each set of 25 points for first 4 sets and 15 points for 5th set), applicable for all the matches of group league and knock out stage
2. Service, points, deuce and other rules as per standard volleyball rules and matches will be conducted by the officials of the authorized association only
3. If a team fails to report on time, the other player / team will be declared as winner of the match
4. On winning a match a team will get 3 points (group league and other rounds)
5. If all the teams or 2 teams of a particular group have same points after all the group matches, the group winner will be decided as per following rules...
 - a) Number of sets won
 - b) Head-to-head
 - c) Toss (if required)

Kindly Note: The details mentioned above are for tentative guidance only. All relevant information will be shared with the participants and respective teachers before each game discipline begins. The decision of the match officials and management will be final in any regard

General Rules & Regulations:

1. Every school needs to send its athletes / participants for the game days, opening & closing ceremonies by its own transportation and facilities; the final game schedule will be provided to participating schools by 9th December, 2025 (Tuesday)
2. Athletes / participants should come with their own sport kits. The organizing committee will not provide any sport-specific equipment, other than balls, shuttlecocks, and similar items
3. Athletes / participants must reach the venue on time, as per the final schedule and must report at least 45 minutes before their game starts at the designated help desk of the game venues for the verification (e.g., for a scheduled 09:30 am match, reporting is required by 08:45 am). Failing to arrive on time will lead to disqualification. Help desk will open from 8:30 am on every game day at the respective venues

4. Every school should send its athletes / participants in their own sports jerseys to maintain uniformity; however, the organizing committee will also provide TOK jerseys to every participant
5. All athletes / participants and school representatives must collect their bib, wrist band, certificate of participation, TOK jersey, and game area access pass (applicable for teachers only) prior to the commencement of the tournament from the designated distribution counter. A school may assign a school teacher / student / office staff with valid ID / authorization letter to collect the items on behalf of the school.

Kindly Note: The distribution counter will be operational from 9th – 11th December, 2025 (Tuesday – Thursday), everyday from 11:00am to 06:00pm (daily) at Techno India, Salt Lake Campus, EM 4/1, Sector V, Salt Lake, Kolkata – 700091. No items will be provided after the above-mentioned date and time or @ the help desk of any venue before the commencement of the games. Please contact Subhendu Pollya @ +91 6291253839 for any details regarding distribution counter

6. It is mandatory to produce the original copy of the valid school id of every athlete / participant, and teacher of every participating school at the distribution counter (**if not uploaded during the online process**) for the collection of required items and access pass. No athlete will be allowed to participate in any game discipline without the valid BIB (which will be verified by the organizing committee and game officials before the commencement of the games). Similarly, no teachers will be allowed to access the game areas without the valid access card (nontransferable) assigned by the organizing committee.

Valid School ID of the Athletes (Original Copy – Any One Document): School I-Card, School Registration Certificate, Latest Mark Sheet with Attested Photo, Fees Book with Attested Photo (No authorization letter will be accepted)

Valid School ID of the Teachers (Original Copy): School I-Card (No authorization letter will be accepted)

Kindly Note: It is advisable for the athletes and teachers to carry their original school IDs, which will be required in case of any objections from other schools or if a BIB or access card is lost or damaged

7. Breakfast and Lunch (Veg) boxes will be provided to all athletes and teachers of the school on game days according to the schedule. Evening snacks will be provided during the opening and closing ceremonies. Teachers from participating schools who have an access pass must collect the food boxes for all participants and teachers from the designated food counter during game days and opening & closing ceremony. There will be an adequate number of water stations at the venues; however, it is advisable that the athletes carry their own water bottles
8. It is mandatory to dump food boxes, napkins, water glasses, and other waste in the bins kept in various corners of the grounds. Accompanying teachers must supervise this to keep the ground clean
9. Decision on any matter regarding the event will be taken by the organizing committee in consultation with match officials only
10. All games will be officiated by the authorized officials

11. The help desk at the venue can be contacted for any assistance during the games
12. Each participating school is requested to send at least five students and teachers to attend both the opening and closing ceremonies. Participants will take part in the march past and flag hoisting at the opening and receive any awards at the closing
13. In case an athlete or school is unable to collect the certificate, medal, and trophy (if any) during the closing ceremony, they can be collected on 18th & 19th December, 2025, from (Thursday & Friday) from 11:30am to 3:30pm (daily) at the Techno India, Salt Lake Campus, EM 4/1, Sector V, Salt Lake, Kolkata - 700091. The organizing committee will not be held responsible for the items after the aforementioned dates
14. **Selection of Champion, and 2nd - 4th Position:** The four schools with the highest points in the medal tally will be awarded accordingly, as Champion, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th. If two or more schools are tied on points, the winners will be selected based on the following parameters:

Maximum number of gold medal won >> Maximum number of silver medal won >> Maximum number of medals won >> Maximum number of team game won (Football, Kabaddi, Table Tennis (Doubles - Junior & Senior), Badminton (Doubles - Junior & Senior), Basketball, and Volleyball) >> Toss

15. Participating school authorities are requested to read the documents carefully before the online registration
